
3. HE IS A PERSON

How did God make men and women?

The 'real you' is not just your body. That is only the house you live in! The 'real you' is your soul and spirit. Look at the diagram below:



Although God does not have a physical body, He made us like Himself, with a soul and spirit. Our soul is the part of us that has the ability to think, feel and make decisions. When we come to Jesus our spirit comes alive and we are able to have a relationship with God, as God is Spirit.

Some religions believe that there are many gods but the Bible teaches us that there is one true God. He is so great that there is nothing or no-one to compare with Him. In Isaiah 40 it says this about God: "To whom then can we compare God? ... Can He be compared to an idol? ... It is God who sits above the circle of the earth.
