
Leaving the Past (1)

Another problem many of us have is that we have been hurt by others. We may feel angry, bitter and not willing to forgive that person. We want to 'pay them back' for what they have done!

Forgiveness is so important. If we don't forgive we become like prisoners! God wants us to be free and know His power and love in our lives.

In English we sometimes say: "Don't leave any stone unturned." This means we are not to leave anything hidden in darkness! If there is anything in our lives that is not right, allow the Holy Spirit to show you and ask God to work in your life. God loves us so much and wants the very best for our lives – don't allow anything to stay in your life that will hinder your relationship with Him.
