# 10. Godly Relationships

#### **Introduction**

**Scripture Reading:** Ephesians 5:21–6:9

#### 1. Our relationships with one another 5:21

**†** What does it really mean to 'submit to one another'? How does that apply to a relationship between someone in a more senior position, and someone in a junior position? (It could be in the work place, the church, school or university.)

#### 2. The relationships between husbands and wives 5:22-33

- **†** Paul addresses wives first and tells them to honour their husbands and submit to them. Why do you think it is important for wives to do this?
- **†** Husbands are told 3 times to love their wives. Why do you think they need to be reminded so many times?

# 3. The relationships between children and parents 6:1-4

**†** Sadly in this world we are seeing great rebellion and disregard for authority. And it begins in the home! What are the 'ingredients' to raise Godly children? Share from these verses and also from your experience.

# 4. The relationships between employees and employers 6:5-9

**†** Although Paul is writing about the relationship between slaves and their masters, how do these verses apply today to our relationships with employers? Discuss.
