## 11. Living in God's Love

## Introduction

- What does God do for his children according to verses 29 and 30? What does this really mean?

- What difference will it make in our lives if we really understand what God has done for us? v31-32
- Read verses 33 to 39 and spend time meditating on these verses. Share a verse or phrase that inspires you and what this means to you.
