Introduction

We have often heard the phrase, 'The End Times'. There are many passages in the Bible that refer to the events that will <u>take place</u> in those days. These events are described in the book of Revelation as the 7 Seals and the 7 Trumpets. Just as there was a pause after the 6th seal to see what is happening to the church, so there is a pause after the 6th Trumpet to hear what God is saying to his prophets and witnesses.
