- What will the return of Jesus be like for unbelievers? v1-3
- Why does Paul say His return should be different for us? v4-6
- What can we learn from the illustrations that Paul uses, of a pregnant woman and a thief, that will help us be ready for the Lord's return?
- 3. <u>Our Preparation</u> 1 Thessalonians 5:8-11
- How are we to prepare ourselves according to v8? How do we do this?
- We are also told to encourage each other so we will all be ready. v11 Share a time when someone has encouraged you in the past, and how this has helped you not to give up.
- Is there someone you know who seems to be slipping away that you need to encourage right now? Pray together for these friends.
