B. ABBRAHAM'S RECOMMITMENT

- ☆ How does God intervene to prevent further wrong doing? V17-19
- ☆ In what way does God show his faithfulness to Abraham at this time, and why does he? Genesis 13:2-3
- No doubt Abraham felt embarrassed and ashamed of what he had done. How did he respond to the Lord at that time? Genesis 13:3-4



Have there been times in your life when you have made mistakes, yet you have seen God graciously preventing you from going further? What other lessons can you learn from this story?
